

## Director's Report Dec 2025

- Attended final budget review for Select Board and Budget Committee on December 8<sup>th</sup>. No new questions so our next meeting will be the January 14<sup>th</sup> public hearing on the budget then the Feb 5 Town Deliberative session.
- Reviewed policies to update, particularly in light of the amendment to RSA Section 201-D:11- II-a. We'll be adjusting our confidentiality policy.
- FINALLY we have new chairs in the Crowley Room! New tables will arrive week after Christmas. Town hall took the old ones and the table to replace older items in the rec dept office.
- Still trying to get Comcast to give us a new pricing contract for internet and phones but equipment renting fees are increasing.
- Patron visits are following the patterns of each year, but we still have folks coming to many of our programs- 551 in November came to our onsite programs. 45 people came to our Poinsettia tea on Friday!
- Winter read challenge for kids and adults coming up in January- a smaller version of summer reading program but still read for prizes and challenges to try new authors and genres.
